- (v) To conduct vocational Education Guidance, Training and skill Development Programmes, and according software Development, Computer Programming, Communication, IT, Electronic and printing technologies development and utilities, vocational education, research training and development programmes and award certificates.
- (vi) To organise activities for the promotion of physical, mental, spiritual and educational development and upliftment of adults and children without any distinction of caste, creed or religion etc and in the interest of mankind, in general.
- (vii) To aid, establish, takeover or collaborate with any institution or association, having indetical aims and objects as that of the Trust for physical, mental, spiritual, educational development for upliftment of society.
- (viii) To establish any institution or adopt means for promoting any art, science or knowledge in any other field of education, propagating fur removal of social evils, customs or for promoting self help to overcome these evils in society.
- (ix) To establish any institution or society for the welfare of victims of natural calamities and to provide food and shelter to needy person from time to time.

 - (xiv) To promote spiritual studies and open spiritual training and Yoga centres for general public and to do everything to make spiritual studies popular amongst the public.
 - (xv) To establish, found and maintain libraries, and reading rooms for the use and convenience of general public.
 - (xvi) To undertake innovative projects in field of integrated remote rural development, Human resource Development, Health and family welfare, science and technology, social justice and empowerment, Environment and forests studies Management, Conservation and development, communication; id electronics, information Technologies and Youth and Sports.
 - (xvii) To engage, employ or hire appropriate staff, workers, legal experts and other professional, attorneys, managers and agents for the work and furtherance of the aims and objects of the Trust and to pay their wages, salaries, stipend - fees etc.
 - (xviii) To purchase/ make construction land and / or building in the name of the Trust and the trust thereupon for the fulfillment of the aims & objects of the trust.
 - (xix) To do such acts/activities which are necessary and which may be incidental to the attainment of any of the object of the trust.

5. BOARD OF TRUSTEES

- (i) The Board of Trustees shall consist of not less than FIVE and not more than FIFTEEN members.
- (ii) The following shall be the First Board of Trustees :
1. Sri Abhishek Kumar Singh
 2. Mrs. Vimla Singh
 3. Mrs. Sangita Deva
 4. Sri Shankar Mahto
 5. Sri Indrajit Jha
- (iii) Sri Abhishek Kumar Singh shall be the Managing Trustee and will hold office for life time or until he resigns.
- (iv) In the event of the office of the managing trustee becoming vacant, his wife, sons and daughter or any body else as per his/her will, shall become the managing trustee for life and so on for subsequent successors. In the event of there being no will of the managing trustee, the trustees shall elect the managing trustee from amongst members of the family of the founder managing trustee. If none of the members of the family of the founder managing trustee is willing or available, the trustees shall elect the managing trustee from amongst themselves.
- (v) The Board of Trustees may co-opt persons if necessary, to raise the total number of members to Fifteen.
- (vi) The managing Trustee shall be free to co-opt any person who may be helpful in achieving the objects of the trust as a trustee.
- (vii) A trustee shall cease to hold office of the Trust if the trustee becomes insane or lunatic or insolvent or bankrupt.
- (viii) All other trustees, except Managing Trustee shall hold office for THREE YEARS from the dates of their appointment / nomination and other completion of the terms, their office will automatically become vacated but such trustees can be reappointed / renominated on the expiry of the term.
- (ix) The Board of Trustees shall have powers to make rules for any matter not provided herein.

6. POWERS AND FUNCTION OF THE TRUST

- (i) The Board of Trustees may by resolution extend / amend / alter / modify

- (ii) The Board shall maintain a minutes book in which proceedings of all meetings of the Board shall be recorded and the same shall be signed by the Chairman of the meeting.
- (iii) The Board shall have powers to frame rules and regulations as to the duties and responsibilities of each trustee, and for appointment / constitution of executive committee, Sub-committee, advisory board, and for conducting any other matter connected with the administration of the trust management, and shall
 - (a) appoint auditor of the Trust and make fixation of their remuneration.
 - (b) approve and adopt Annual Account Report, Auditor's Report, Balance Sheet, Income and Expenditure Account, Receipts and Payments Account of the Trust.
 - (c) accept any donation, contribution, grant or subscription in cash or in kind, from any person(s) body of persons or Trust, with or without condition,
 - (d) apply the whole or any part of the income of the Trust, or the Trust fund or accumulations thereto, to any one or more of the objects of the trust, as the trustees may, in their discretion, deem fit from time to time.
 - (e) borrow or raise or secure payments of moneys and also to lend money either with or without security.
 - (f) sell, dispose of alienate or otherwise deal with any property of the Trust.
 - (g) let out or dispose off an immovable property of the Trust for such period and rent on such terms and conditions as the Trustees in their discretion may think fit.
 - (h) open account in the name of the Trust, with a Bank or Banks, to operate such account and to give instructions to the Bank and to provide for opening and operation of such account by one or more of the Trustees or by an agent appointed by the trustees.
 - (i) adjust, settle compromise, compound refer to arbitration, all actions, suits claims, demands and proceedings regarding the Trust Fund.
 - (j) appoint or make provision for the appointment of any persons (including all or any of the Trustees and committees or administrator or managing Trustees or otherwise) for the purpose of the administration of the Trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulation as the Trustees may prescribe.

- (k) make, vary, alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for attainment of the objects of the Trust and for the management of the affairs thereof or for running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the Trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the Trust.
- (l) start, abolish, discontinue and restart any charity or charitable institutions for the benefit of genral public and to impose any condition to any subscription or donation to be made by them.
- (m) set apart and / or allocate the whole or a part of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or part thereof for any of the objects of the Trust.
- (n) join, co-operate or amalgamate this trust with other or others haivng kindred or allied objects, upon such terms and conditions as the trustees may in their discretion think fit, particularly having regard to and in conformity with the objects and nature of this Trust.
- (o) give aid by way of donations out of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or otherwise, to different charitable institutions, societies, organizaitons of Trustees in India which may have been established or which may hereinafter be established for charitable purposes mentioned in these presents or any of them to enable such institutions, societies, organizaiton or Trustees to start maintain, or carry out such charitable activities.
- (p) settle all accounts and to compromise, abandon, or refer to arbitration any action or proceedings or disputes, claims, demands or things, as deemed proper for such purpose without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby.
- (q) borrow money either on the security of any property of the Trust or otherwise for all or any of the purposes of the Trust, and it shall be lawful for the Trustee to make such borrowings on payment of such interest or otherwise on such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit.
- (r) apply to the Government, public bodies, urban, local, municipal, district and other bodies, corporation, companies, or persons for grant of money and of aid, donations, gifts, subscriptions, affiliation and other assistance with a view to promoting the objects of the Trust and to negotiate with the Government Departments, public and other Bodies, corporations, companies or persons, scheme and other works and matters within the objects of the Trust and to accept any proper conditions on which such grants and other payments may be made.

institution or institutions having objects either wholly or in part similar to the objects of this Trust and on such terms and conditions as may be thought expedient.

- (t) purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagements of any or more of the trust, societies, institutions or associations with which this Trust is authorised to amalgamate.

7. FINANCE

- (i) All the activities of the Trust shall be Non Profitable and shall be done on 'No Profit - No Loss' basis.
- (ii) The Trustees shall be accountable only for such money and funds which will actually come into their hand.
- (iii) At the beginning the Trust will be run with a Fund of Rs. twenty one thousand only which will be given by Smt. Nivedita Singh W/o Sri Abhishek Kumar Singh, the managing Trustee, and thereafter with the funds collected through fees and subscriptions from students and other persons who receive benefit from the Institutions run by the Trust.
- (iv) The Trust will accept donation and volunteer contribution in any form from individual or organization it may accept aid from Government or corporate body or raise fund by borrowing money with or without interest from bank, Financial, Institution or individuals. The borrowed money will be returned as per the terms and conditions of the loan.
- (v) All the incomes, earnings, movable / immovable properties of the Trust shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of its aims and Objects as set forth hereinabove and no profit thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus, profits or in any manner whatsoever to any present or the past member of the Trust or to any other person. No member of the Trust shall have any personal claim on any movable or immovable property of the Trust or make any profit, whatsoever, by virtue of his membership.
- (vi) The Trust Fund may be augmented by the income from the initial Fund and also by donations and other contribution from time to time.
- (vii) The Trust Fund shall not be applied to any purpose other than those specified in Article 4 herein above unless the other objects added to the trust objectives.
- (viii) The Fund of the Trust shall be utilized for the maintenance, development and expansion of the Trust and institution run by the Trust. Any immovable property acquired shall be registered in the name of the Trust or institutions

- (ix) The Trustees shall always maintain proper accounts of the Trust, which shall be kept at the office of the Trust. The accounts will be audited once in a year by a qualified Auditor appointed by the Board of Trustees.
- (x) The Financial year of the Trust shall be from April to March.
- (xi) The Bank Account of the Trust shall be opened in any scheduled bank at Begusarai to be jointly operated by the Managing Trustee and another member of the Board of Trustees.

8. MEETING AND DECISIONS

- (i) The office of the Trust shall be situated at Begusarai or at any other place decided by the Board of trustees.
- (ii) The Board of Trustees shall meet at least once in three month either at the Registered office of the Trust or at the residence of any member of the Trust. One third members shall form the quorum. Ordinarily seven clear days notice shall be required for calling a meeting but in exceptional circumstances there may be an emergent meeting even at one day's notice.
- (iii) All decisions at a meeting of the Board shall be taken by simple majority of the members present and voting at the meeting. However, for amending any provision(s) of the constitution of the Trust, two third number of members present and voting shall be required.

9. CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP

- (i) Every Trustee will be at liberty to resign from his office by giving one month's notice of his intention to do so.
- (ii) A person shall cease to be a Trustee :
 - (a) If he/she, without leave of absence, fails to attend three consecutive meetings of the Board of Trustee
 - (b) If he is requested to resign by two third number of members of the remianing Trustees.

10. DISSOLUTION

If at least two third number of members of the Board of Trustees resolve to dissolve the Trust and get it replaced by another Trust, in a meeting specially called for the purpose, the Trust shall dissolve and be replaced by a substitute Trust as per the resolution adopted in that special Meeting.
